Directions for Installing the Moodle App via the App store & Google Play Store (Apple & Android users)

- 1. Open App store or Google Play store
- 2. Search "Moodle Desktop" (Apple users) or "Moodle" (Android users)
- 3. Select the Moodle App (see picture on the right) and download the app.
- 4. Once you have opened the app, you are given the option to login to the course using the course URL (link) or through scanning the QR code provided above.
 - a. If you have decided to login using the **course URL**, then copy and paste the course URL where it says "Your Site" on the Moodle home page.
 - i. Copy the Building GBV Evidence Course URL and paste it to where it says "Your site" on the Moodle home page.
 - ii. Several learning portals will appear. Select the option by a pencil icon that says "Connect to your site" (learn.globalwomensinstitute.gwu)
 - b. If you have decided to login using the **QR code** provided above, then select the option "Scan **QR code**"
 - i. A popup box titled "Where can I find the QR code?" will appear. Ignore this message and select the option "Next"
 - ii. Scan the QR code provided on the Capacity Building Course section of the Building GBV Evidence website.
- 5. Enter your username and password for the GWI learning portal.
- 6. You should now be on your dashboard. To go to the Building GBV Evidence course, click on the top right option that says, "Site home".
- 7. Click "available courses" and select the building GBV Evidence course in your desired language.
- 8. You have now logged into your Moodle account.

How to Download the Building GBV Evidence Capacity Building Course via the Moodle App for Offline Use

- 1. On the upper right corner of the course home page, locate the **cloud icon**. Click on the cloud icon.
- 2. If you wish to download the whole course in order to access the course offline, select the "Download course" option on the top of your screen.
- 3. If you wish to download individual sessions of the course, manually click the cloud icon for each session. The cloud icons are located right beside the session name.
- 4. Once you have downloaded the session, the cloud icon will appear green meaning you have successfully downloaded your desired course session.
